



#### **Executive summary**

The briefing material has been designed and developed to give participants an introduction to the different aspects of the topic of debate, namely *Environment and Climate Change*, and the selected subtopics: Sustainable Mobility, Sustainable Food Consumption, and Plastic Pollution.

The first version, edited by the UW and UNISI team with the cooperation of all partners, has formed the basis of the pilot events with schools and universities, held in the period 28 November – 16 December 2022.

Based on students and facilitators' feedback and evaluation (January 2023), a second version has been drafted by the UNISI team and discussed with local partners (UP8, MP, USTUTT, DCU, UW) at the end of January 2023.

Following the main experiment deliberation design, developed by partners in the period February 2023 – May 2023, further changes and integrations have been made:

- A short introduction to deliberation has been added, as for familiarize participants to the overall process and raise awareness on the crucial role of deliberation for contemporary democracies.
- For each topic, information on EU level, national level and local level have been provided.
- Briefing materials have been edited as an interactive multimedia PDF file, in order to help participants to explore the topic and immediately find the information of interest.
- A set of videos were created especially for the last event of the deliberation process, the European plenary conference, to make it more effective and interactive.

These changes are the result of the following activities:

- Co-design sessions and bilateral exchanges with civil servants from the involved cities, aimed to collect relevant information on the topic at local level (January-April 2023).
- Bilateral exchanges with experts on EU goals, policies and measures on environment and climate change, aimed to implement the information on EU initiatives on the topic (March 2023). Involved experts: Simone Bastianoni, Nadia Marchetti, Federico Pulselli, Federico Rossi, Valentina Nicolucci, Paola Abanese (Ecodynamics group, University of Siena).
- Brainstorming sessions with partners & team, held both in person, during the General Assembly, and online (4 sessions in total), aimed to design effective and engaging outputs (January-April 2023)
- Interviews to the CoR members from the involved countries on the topics of debate have been performed by tour4EU team, with the aim of filling the gap between citizens and elites and let participants know what the cities and the EU have done and are doing to face the climate change and foster sustainability (May 2023)
- Final editing by the UNISI team (May 2023).







The final version of the briefing materials consists of two main outputs:

- 1. A multimedia interactive PDF document, translated in all languages and shared with participants a few days before the start of the experiment via a website specially created for the purpose by NH.
- 2. A YouTube playlist, including texts and subtitles in all languages, shared with participants during the final EU event by the session manager.
